

Updated Guidelines Based on CDC Guidelines

Masks are required for all students, staff, faculty and visitors at all school functions.

Quarantine Time

Quarantine time is 5 days after a confirmed infection. (Confirmed via a test) If no symptoms or symptoms are resolving after 5 days, you can return to school.

Fever

If you have a fever, continue to stay home until the fever resolves. You can return to school 24 hours after fever resolves.

Who does not need to quarantine?

If you came into close contact with someone with Covid-19 and you are age 5 to 17 and completed the primary series of Covid-19 vaccines and are not showing any symptoms.

Who should quarantine?

If you come in close contact with someone with Covid-19 and you are not vaccinated.

Close Contact

Close for a total of 15 minutes). Someone who was less than <u>6 feet away from infected</u> <u>person</u> (laboratory-confirmed or a <u>clinical diagnosis</u>) for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period.

Exception: The **indoor classroom** setting excludes students if both the infected student and the exposed student(s) <u>correctly and consistently</u> wore well-fitting <u>masks</u> the entire time.

Teachers, staff, or other adults follow the same rules as students if positive or close contact. Quarantine time is 5 days.

The school office will notify you of a return date for your student should they be out due to illness.

These guidelines will remain in effect until the board reviews any CDC guideline changes or suggestions.
